- 1. **Selection Process:** Candidates have been selected as per the Institute's norms. No further communication, recommendations, or requests will be entertained regarding this selection. Candidates who are not selected for this programme may be considered for future workshops or training programmes, subject to availability and approval by the competent authorities.
- 2. **Reporting Requirements:** At the time of reporting for the training programme, each participant must carry the original ID proof (e.g., Passport, Aadhar Card, or any other ID card issued by the State or Central Government). Participants should also submit a photocopy of the ID proof along with a photocopy of the front page of their bank passbook, showing the account details (Name, Account Number, and IFSC Code).
- 3. **Required Materials:** Participants selected for the programme are requested to bring textbooks related to Kashmiri language and literature, as well as Kashmiri grammar, which are used in the classroom for teaching and learning Kashmiri.
- 4. **Attendance and Participation:** Full attendance and active participation are mandatory for eligibility to receive a certificate and local conveyance. The local conveyance allowance will be credited to the provided bank account within 30 working days following the conclusion of the programme.
- 5. **Meals and Refreshments:** Working lunch and refreshments will be provided according to the extended norms of CIIL.
- 6. **Accommodation:** No accommodation will be arranged by Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL), Mysuru
